The instructors for this seminar are from across the United States and have many years of investigative experience involving Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs and have a wealth of information to share with fellow officers. The instructors have participated in surveillance, intelligence gathering, undercover operations, and as case agents in the prosecution of OMG members from all over the United States. Instructors will also be presenting actual audio and videotapes from investigations involving OMG members and surveillance videos captured from significant events.
